



2016 PROJECT SUBMISSIONS TO THE TRUST

From January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016 the Rainy River First Nations Trust received a total of 28 project submissions. Of the 28 submissions received, a total of 21 have been approved for funding. Approvals may span beyond the 2016 calendar year.

Applicants to the Trust can apply for funding under section 8.2 b of the Trust Agreement. This section defines ten areas under which applications can be made. The diagram below outlines the ten areas under which the 28 project were submitted.
