PROJECT SUBMISSIONS TO THE TRUST

For 2017, Trustee appointments directly impacted the review of project submissions. Effective June 1, 2017, Community Fund Trustee appointments dropped to two from a total of four. As directed by the Trust Agreement, once Community Fund Trustee appointments are three or less then Trustees are precluded from reviewing and approving expenditures. Community Fund Trustees maintained quarterly and monthly deadlines for 2017 and all submissions were logged, filed and placed in queue for review once new Trustee appointments are made.

From January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017 the Rainy River First Nations Trust received a total of 31 project submissions. Of the 31 submissions received, a total of 17 were reviewed and 14 were placed in the queue for review once Trustees are appointed. As a result, approvals for 2017 projects will span beyond the 2017 calendar year.

Applicants to the Trust apply for funding under section 8.2(b) of the Trust Agreement. This section defines ten areas under which applications can be made. The diagram below outlines the ten areas under which the 31 project were submitted.

2017PROJECTS APPROVED FOR FUNDING

From January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017 the Rainy River First Nations Trust received a total of 31 project submissions. Of the 31 submissions received, a total of 17 were reviewed, with 11 approved for funding during 2017. The remaining 14 projects will be placed in the queue to be reviewed once new Community Fund Trustee appointments are made. The following information outlines the 8.2 b area of approval and the project title. Please note that approval for funding does not mean that the funding was released and/or that project activities began.
